

## Sr Connie Mac Playoff Game - Pro Rules

Runner on first - Less than two outs

Batter hits a fly ball to center field which is easily caught by the center fielder.

The Center fielder, seeing the runner at first off the bag, tries to throw him out.

As the runner is sliding back into first the ball skips past the first basemen and hits the retired batter-runner in foul territory.

Notes on the play:

- The retired runner did not intentionally interfere with the play,
- No one was backing up the ball throw to the first basemen, so if the ball did not hit the batter-runner it would have gone out of play

You make the call:

1. Dead ball - Leave the runner at first
2. Dead ball - Award the runner third because the ball would have gone out of play
3. Dead Ball - Runner is out on the retired runners interference
4. Live ball - None of the above
